You can try this experience in multiple ways—by checking out our Vox Books, which have a built-in speaker, or by streaming an e-audiobook while reading a print copy of the same title.
- For assigned reading, Libby also includes helpful tools like highlighting and bookmarking, which can support focus and retention by making the reading experience more interactive.



- A pair of noise-reducing headphones to reduce background noise




# SMART BAGS




