The group discussed upcoming events:

She will contact the library to confirm set up, call PD to confirm police presence, print out all materials needed and send a follow up email to all those registered to attend. She will look for swag to add to mugs we will sticker and give to all the books who participate. S. DelVillano-Marchi confirmed she will pick up the eight \$10 Starbuck's cards. We will assemble the gifts this week or just before the event.

May 19 Page Turners Social - The event will be held outdoors if weather cooperates. M. Mazur attended the Macomb County Volunteer Awards recently and said lots of people were interested in this event as well as the Human Library and other events.

May 28 - New Resident Meet and Greet - Melanie got the list of addresses. We will be hosting a social media contest for National Do Something Good for Your Neighbor Day on May 16. We will determine the prize - it could be that they receive a nice neighbor at an upcoming council meeting as well as a stake sign for their front yard that proclaims they won this contest. M. Mazur asked if we could bring another black board with sticky notes and sharpies so people can answer the question of "what does community mean to you?" T. Graphenreed asked if we can add "what would you like to do for your community" and/or "how have you contributed to your community?" M. Davis said we still have sticky notes and black poster boards left over, so she didn't see why we couldn't make that happen. The group offered to help stuff letters sometime next week when we have them ready. M. Davis will update the run of show / script and bring to May meeting.
