ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

At a session of the 41A District Court, held in the City of Sterling Heights, County of Macomb, Michigan, on Wednesday, May 12, 1999,

Present: Honorable Kenneth J. Kosnic, Chief Judge

The 41A District Court, Sterling Heights Division, pursuant to M.C.R. 8.110, adopts the following, as it relates to the closure of the Court, due to a weather emergency:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, if a weather emergency exists in the eyes of the Chief Judge, or his specific designee, the Court shall be closed and the employees dismissed. If this situation occurs, coincident with the current International Union of American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Local 1884 Council 25 contract, the employees of the court shall be guaranteed a minimum of seven (7) hours pay at their regular rate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon closure of the Court, due to a weather emergency, the local control unit and regional media outlets, as well as the local law enforcement agency - the Sterling Heights Police Department, shall be notified of such closure by the Court Administrator.

Also, upon such closure of the Court, the Court Administrator shall post a public notice on the public entrance to the Court, notifying the public of closure.
