





Dear Community Residents,

We are proud to report that the Sterling Heights Area Community Foundation continued to fulfill its mission in 2019 by improving the cultural, educational and recreational opportunities for Sterling Heights area residents.

Year end assets totaled \$978,174 after 2019 grant disbursements of \$44,300 for a variety of activities supporting the foundation's mission. Managed endowment funds totaled 27. Since its inception in 1991, the Foundation has contributed more than \$1.3 million to organizations and activities that support its mission.

In 2019, the foundation supported many community efforts with financial grants and conducted a variety of activities to generate funds for future use in improving the quality of life of area residents.
