Subject: 17 Mile Road Improvements Project – Mound Road to Van Dyke Avenue

Dear Property Owner,

The City of Sterling Heights would like to inform you about the upcoming improvements project on 17 Mile Road between Mound Road and Van Dyke Avenue, scheduled to begin July 28, 2025, with substantial completion anticipated by early-November 2025.

This project will contain a newly paved asphalt roadway, landscaped median islands to improve traffic safety, and aesthetic improvements on the 17 Mile Road bridge. The work will be completed in two phases:

- Phase One: The outer lanes of 17 Mile Road will be closed to traffic to allow for construction work. During this time, all traffic will be shifted to the inner three lanes.
- Phase Two: Upon completion of the outer lanes, the inner three lanes will then be closed. Traffic will be redirected to the newly constructed outer lanes for the duration of this phase. Some left turn movements may be limited to allow for construction and signs posted.

Throughout the construction period, access to all driveways and businesses will be maintained. Some temporary disruptions may occur, but crews will work to minimize impacts and ensure safe access at all times.
