Our levels are color coded as they progress upward through the rainbow of colors. Each level adds to the difficulty, technicality and complexity of each step. Each child progresses at their own pace so ages in each level will vary based on practice, retention, if they take multiple classes and years of dance consecutively taken. All first and second year dancers should enroll in RED classes, unless otherwise told by an instructor.


TINY TAPPERS

MUSICAL THEATER DANCE

(Age 5+)

Musical theatre dancing is less of a particular style and more of a description of dancing that is rooted in the diverse history of Broadway musicals. Relying on a basic knowledge of ballet, tap and jazz. Musical theater dancers are actors and place a focus on musical interpretation. Matching their body and facial features to the words.

BATON TWIRLING

(Age 5+)

Twirling combines dance, agility, coordination and flexibility while manipulating a single baton or multiple batons. Twirler will be measured & weighted batons can be purchased the first day of class for **\$35**.

Red - Your dancer will learn the twenty basic baton tricks in their right hand then their left, practicing these tricks and then adding them to music.

Orange, Green & Yellow - As your dancer masters the twenty basic tricks then will continue to add and expand on these tricks adding more difficulty and smoothing out the flow and technique.

Novelty - Novelty is for any dancer that has taken at least one or more years of baton. They will use the basic tricks and expand them using different twirling items and props.

2 & 3 Baton - This class is designed for any twirler that has currently taken 1 or more years of baton and is interesting in learning or advancing their skills twirling 2 & 3 batons.

Attire: Dancer must wear a leotard or stretchy clothes, NO JEANS, hair pulled back.

Tennis shoes are acceptable for class, Tan Jazz or Turner for recital.

Any dancers registered in a Blue/Purple class will have the option to audition for the Sterling Stars Opening Recital Number.

Spots are limited to 25 dancers. Dancers are responsible for learning the choreography on their own. Material will be provided 2 weeks prior to auditions and they are required to audition in person (no videos will be allowed) for a chance to receive a spot in the opening number. Genres in the opening number will include: Ballet/Lyrical, Jazz/Pom, Hip Hop, Tap & Baton. Dancers can audition for as many genres as they wish, but might only be placed in one. **Please keep in mind that not every dancer that auditions will get a spot.**



Dancers that receive a spot will be required to attend **ALL Tuesday Practices** unless arrangements have been made in advanced and approved by an instructor.
