The One Year Action Plan and Projected Use of Funds will be submitted after citizen participation and involvement in the selection of projects.

The Sterling Heights Citizen Advisory Committee is conducting the regular meeting for December 7, 2020 by video conference in accordance with Gov. Gretchen Whitmer's Executive Order No. 2020-15 and Executive Order 2020- 21. This notice is required by Executive Order No. 2020-15 to ensure that those wishing to observe and/or participate in this regular meeting have the opportunity to do so. This regular meeting will take place at 6:00 p.m., on December 7th, 2020.
